Holbrook Public School provides broad, creative and relevant learning programs that encourage every student from Kindergarten to Year 6 to reach their full potential.

Our core business is the teaching, learning, wellbeing and achievement of our students. We are recognised for our outstanding academic achievements, brought about by a team of teachers and staff, dedicated to a culture of constant improvement and evidence-informed teaching strategies.

Providing a variety of learning opportunities

Debating, public speaking, chess, academic and sporting competitions are just some of the co-curricular activities offered at Holbrook Public School. We also have a proud history of success in developing knowledge and skills in the creative and performing arts.

Music, dance (recognised across the region and state) and drama, provide students with many opportunities to perform, including performance evenings, competitions, community events and speech nights. Our students continue to achieve outstanding success in this area.

Our visual arts programs engage students in a range of creative activities, such as painting, drawing, sculpture and visual design. Student artworks are proudly displayed around the school and within the community.

Focusing on literacy and numeracy

To ensure quality teaching and learning for our students, we offer a broad and engaging curriculum catering for all student needs. A strong focus on literacy, numeracy and technology creates a sound learning framework for every child in our school.

In numeracy, the Count Me In Too (CMIT), Targeted Early Numeracy (TEN - for Years K to 2), and Taking Off with Numeracy (TOWN - for Years 3 to 6) programs provide a sound basis for mathematical development. There is an emphasis on the basics of multiplication tables and number facts, allowing for quick and accurate recall and the ability to use algorithms and other problem solving strategies effectively. This ensures a successful progression through numeracy levels.

For literacy, we have a whole-school approach to reading, writing, grammar and spelling. This ensures that explicit, consistent and precise teaching, using evidence-based programs and resources are used at every learning stage. Learning to read and understanding text are the most valuable life-long academic skills a school can offer your child. We pride ourselves on the evidence informed, systematic and sequential programs we have in place to teach reading and writing. These include using the Teaching Literacy, using Synthetic Phonics (TLuSP), MiniLit, MultiLit, Centre for Effective Reading and Focus on Reading programs. The school implements the Best Start program in Kindergarten and continues to monitor individual literacy and numeracy progress through to Year 6, using a range of internal and external data sources. This proactive approach develops deep knowledge and skills in these areas.

Catering for individual student needs

At Holbrook Public School, we believe that children develop at different rates and learn skills in different ways. It is our responsibility to cater for the individual needs, of each child and ensure that every student improves by a minimum of one year's learning growth for one year's teaching. We do this within a stimulating and nurturing environment with an expectation that all students can and will be successful.
