In Week 1, Mrs Wedgwood and Miss Freeman will be on leave until Wednesday. They will be replaced by Judy Wettenhall and Jane Waters respectively. **Curiosity and Powerful Learning** – In Week 2, our executive members of staff will begin their Curiosity and Powerful Learning training. This is a two-year professional learning program designed to maximise the effect of the school plan and drive rigorous school improvement. The program focuses on improvement at a classroom, leadership and system level. Schools are provided with structures to celebrate strategically what teachers do well, and to create a journey for schools to move forward.

**Term 4 Planning Days** – On Tuesday (K-2) and Thursday (3-6) this week, our teachers will participate in a team planning day to collaboratively look at student performance data and work samples, and create programs to support the learning needs of all students. These days are a great way for teachers to prepare for a successful term of learning.

Premier's Debating Challenge – Towards the end of last term our school debating team, supported by Olivia, Jasmyn, Indi, Molly and Digby, completed their final two debates against Albury Public School via video conference. All of our students represented themselves and our school extremely well; however, we were beaten in both debates by very narrow margins. I was very impressed with the development of their arguments and their rebuttal throughout the competition.

Riverina Cricket Trials – Angus and Sam had their final trial for acceptance into the Riverina Cricket Team late last term. The boys are very evenly matched through a range of sports, which I believe has pushed them both to have so much success. Congratulations to Sam, who was chosen to be part of the Riverina team, and well done Angus on an outstanding effort to make it to this level.

**Proud and Deadly Awards** – Six Holbrook Public School students have been nominated to receive Proud and Deadly Awards for their efforts in 2018. These awards celebrate and recognise the excellence and achievement of Riverina Aboriginal students. The awards ceremony will be held at 11:00 am, Glenroy Public School on Thursday 25 October. Parents of students who received an invitation are asked to advise Holbrook Public School if they will be attending as soon as possible.

**Grandparents Day** – This year we will be celebrating Grandparents Day on Friday 26 October. An assembly will be held at 11:00 am in the hall and a P&C morning tea will follow at 11:30 am. **Arrival at School** – Just a reminder that there is no teacher supervision at school until 8:50 am. This is 30 minutes before the beginning of school (9:20 am), when teachers are required to begin work. Arriving earlier than 8:50am can therefore pose a risk to the safety of children. At times, we realise it may be necessary to be at school 5 -10 minutes early on some occasions. Please inform the office in these instances and tell your child/ren to sit under the quiet COLA. On most days, the first bus arrives at 8:50 am.

**Tell Them From Me Parent Survey** – A note will be sent home this week encouraging parents to participate in the Tell Them From Me Parent Survey. Please take the time to complete it so our school can continue to improve.

**Traffic Conditions** – Approximately one month's work has been scheduled for the Holbrook Bypass beginning Tuesday 16 October. Therefore, traffic will be diverted from the Hume Highway to Albury Street, Holbrook during work hours. On weekdays, traffic controllers will be provided by the RMS to help students cross Albury Street at our school crossing between 8:30 am and 9:30 am during this period. In the afternoons, as usual, Holbrook Public School will have a staff member to help students cross Albury Street. Please speak to your children about the increase in traffic and discuss with them the importance of crossing at our school crossing, if necessary.


accompany the children and we thank all supporting parents as well. We wish all teams well and know they will represent our school proudly.

## CHANGED TRAFFIC CONDITIONS ON HUME HIGHWAY AT HOLBROOK

Motorists are advised of changed traffic conditions at Holbrook on the Hume Highway bypass for

The work will be carried out between Tuesday 16 October and Friday 30 November, between 7am and 6pm on weekdays and between 8am and 1pm on Saturdays, weather permitting.


It will involve replacing asphalt on the northbound and southbound carriageways and motorists are advised travel time may increase by up to 10 minutes while work is in progress.

During work hours a reduced speed limit of 40 km/h will be in place and traffic, excluding Higher Mass Limit and Over Size Over Mass vehicles, will be diverted through Albury Street, Holbrook for the safety of


